## INTRODUCTION TO *THE GOSPEL-CENTERED FAMILY* DEVOTIONS

When God commands Adam and Eve to be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth in Genesis 1, God is making known that His design and purpose for the whole of His world is the family. God appoints the family, founded by a man and woman united together in the covenant of marriage, to be the fundamental building block of His world. And God appoints the family to be the instrument He uses to complete His purpose for creation—filling it with a people who love Him and love one another. In this way, God intends what is true of families to be true of His world.

In the midst of a world now plagued and ravaged by sin, God has called your family to offer a foretaste of the abundant life in the Kingdom of God to the world. We have been summoned not to retreat *from the world* but to live *in the world* as living demonstrators and verbal proclaimers of the good news of Jesus.

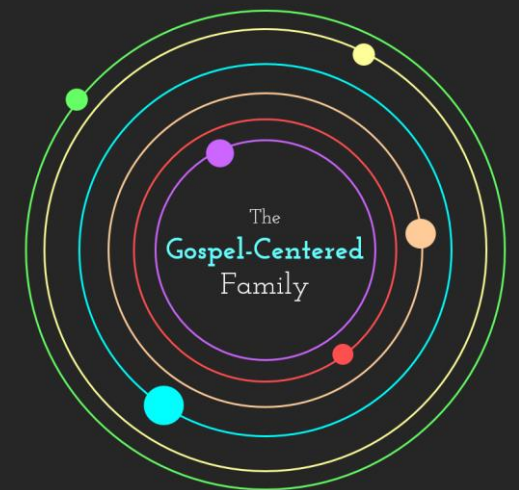
But the work to which God has called your family in public, He designs to fuel in private—around the table and at the bedside. *The Gospel-Centered Family* is offered, especially to fathers and husbands, in the prayerful expectation that these family devotion guides can be a means to fuel the work to which God has called your family. It is offered as a guide to help you pattern and rhythm your family life to the tune of the gospel's song that your family might know it and love it well and invite others to share in its life-giving dance.

While this resource is designed with husbands and fathers in mind, it is by no means offered to the exclusion of single men and women. The elevation of marriage in the life of the church has unintentionally devalued singleness—which Scripture makes clear is a *gift*, not a burden or ailment, for the sake of the gospel. For those to whom God called to singleness—for this season or for life—the basic structure of these devotions can serve as a guide for you as well, leading you to behold the glory of the same God—the Lord over *all* of life.

Fathers and husbands, you do not need to be seminary-educated or an expert in theology to lead your families well. The call to shepherd your family further up and further into the gospel of Jesus is not dependent upon any qualification other than your being a husband and/or father. It is, therefore, nothing short of disobedience to ignore or excuse your appointment by God to lead your family in this way. Be diligent, brothers, to labor in your work as fathers and husbands as faithful keepers of your family. And may the Spirit of God be faithful to fuel your family to be a blessing to those around you and to the ends of the earth.

## HOW TO USE *THE GOSPEL-CENTERED FAMILY* DEVOTIONS

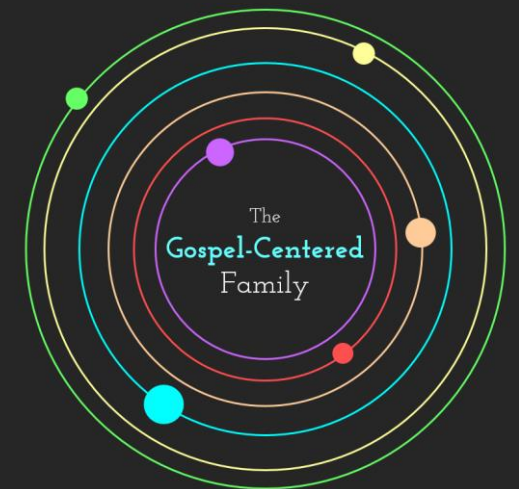
*The Gospel-Centered Family* is a guide. It is more directionally accurate than precise. It is more descriptive than prescriptive. In other words, the structure of *The Gospel-Centered Family* devotions are not meant to be binding. For example, for a father that leaves for work before his children wake up, the structure of a morning Scripture reading is impractical and unhelpful. It will be necessary to adapt and adjust the suggested structure offered within to benefit your family in light of your particular circumstances. Perhaps it is most beneficial for the father who leaves early in the morning to go before his family in reading the morning's Scripture and leave a note of encouragement or insight for his family. Or perhaps it is most beneficial to combine the morning and evening readings into a single evening reading. Again, the structure of Scripture reading and prayer presented in the pages that follow is only one structure among many. As this structure or a modification of this structure is a beneficial tool in shepherding your family, it belongs to you and your family for the glory and honor of Jesus.

The Scripture reading guide is designed for two readings per day—one in the morning and one in the evening. Around the breakfast table and at the bedside, carve out time to wash your family with the water of the Word. The morning readings work through the Psalms and Proverbs two times over the course of one year while the evening readings work through selected readings that convey the single, sweeping narrative from Genesis to Revelation. Prayerfully, this will be an opportunity to orient your family's thinking about and interaction within the world according to the true Story of the whole world at the center of which lies the glorious gospel of Jesus.

The prayer guide offers four categories to help organize your family prayer time—family, church, community and nations—with a few suggested prayers in each. As you daily gather your family together to pray, use these categories to guide your prayers from your immediate family in your home to the unreached peoples at the ends of the earth. Above all, fly all your prayers under the banner of God's glory being displayed and His Kingdom coming in your home, in your church, in your community and in the nations as it is in Heaven.

A word of caution is in order. This family devotion guide is not meant to be a mechanical, empty routine or a means to mere behavior modification for you or your children. The Word of God is both living and life-giving. Therefore, even when you are unaware, as you are faithful to shepherd your family in the Word, you can trust your labors to lead your family in the things of God are not in vain. Further, only the Spirit of God can awaken true obedience in your children. As such, as you pattern the life of your family in a way that treasures Jesus above all things, you can prayerfully expect the Spirit to give your children eyes to look upon Jesus and live.

## NATIONS

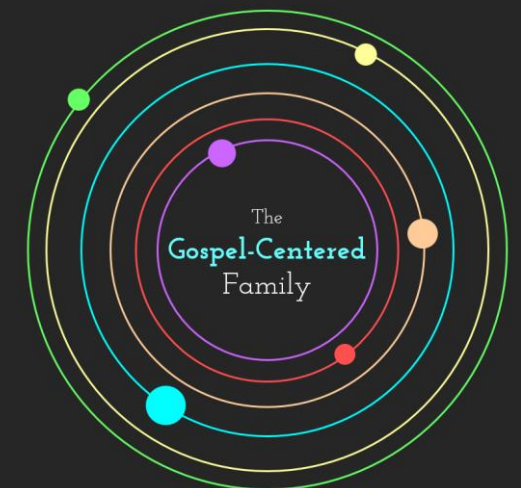
Pray that God would draw all nations to himself; choose one unreached people group to pray for a day
